## Guidelines for Internet Dissemination of Results on NIC Server

NIC has separate Results Hosting platform for Internet dissemination of Results of various Examinations conducted by Boards, Universities, Colleges, Institutions, etc., In order to facilitate Internet publishing of Results smoothly, the following be noted/considered for strict compliance in order to avoid any confusion/problem during release of the results.

1. The results will be hosted only on NIC server, whereas, a link of the Result site may be provided from the website of the concerned organization.
2. The concerned organization will be solely responsible for quality, authenticity & accuracy of the data and results being displayed on Internet. NIC disclaims all and any guarantees, undertakings and warranties, express or implied, and shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever, including incidental or consequential loss or damage, arising out of, or in connection with, any use of or reliance on the results, displayed for the concerned organization.
3. The organization should nominate a person for single point coordination for finalizing Database Structure, Application program, Output Display and procedure for supply of data, besides for finally releasing the results on Internet.
4. The database should be in a single table & should contain Roll No.(as Primary Key), Name of the candidate, Results and other parameters, which need to be displayed through the system i.e., Date of Birth, Centre details, Marks Obtained, etc.
5. The result of any candidate can be viewed by entering Primary Key (i.e., Roll Number), as per the display proforma/screen finalized by the concerned organization.
6. Sample data should be made available to NIC in advance (two working days) for finalization of application program and Output Display. The sample data must contain representative records for proper testing of the application program. Once Database Structure, Application program & Output Display are finalized in consultation with the Coordinator, it should not be changed, except in exceptional conditions. This last moment changes would/may delay the release of Results, for which NIC will not be responsible.
7. The final data must be verified critically and the same should be as per the sample Database Structure. There should not be any duplicate record or mismatch in the database structure, field names, field type & sequence of fields in the final data, supplied to NIC.
8. Complete & final data should be made available to NIC before 3~5 working hours in advance (depending on the volume of the data) for fine tuning of the programs, verification & transmit/porting of data smoothly on the Server located at NIC(HQ) and testing of the Results site, before the official release of the results.
9. The tentative schedule of release of results must be given to NIC in advance (two working days), whereas, final schedule must be intimated in one working day in advance, in order to facilitate making necessary logistic arrangements for release of the results on Internet along with the official release of the results.
